ENERGY-SAVING WORDS FROM THE WISE

- Replace inefficient, outdated or excessive lighting within your building.
- Turn off lights when not in use.
- Set the office thermostats between 78° and 80° during business hours and above 80° during unoccupied hours.
- Check refrigerator door seals by sliding a dollar bill into the door and closing it.
- Set refrigerator temperature between 35° and 38° and freezer at 0°.
- Establish a preventative maintenance program for HVAC.
